** Please note all juniors must be age band J15 or above*
- Please ensure that all entries are supplied with a contact number in the event that the organising committee need to make changes to a crew status or should refunds need to be made.
- Entrance fee: £15 per rowing seat.
- All entry fees must be paid before the draw takes place. Unpaid entries will not be accepted.
- Entries will close at 12:00 on Sunday 8th September.
The Draw will take place on Monday 9th September at 19:00 in The Boathouse, at Boston Rowing Club.
- Payments must be made online by BROE 2 only.
- The draw and event information will be sent out electronically so please ensure all contact details are up to date.

Racing commences at approximately 8:30am. The start order of crews will be slowest to fastest classification, based on the organisers analysis of previous actual results. It will NOT be possible to accommodate requests for variations in start times.
